

# HOW TO HELP YOUR TERMITE PROFESSIONAL\*\*

## **PRIOR TO INSPECTION**

- Do not disturb or spray evidence of termite attack and damage
- Remove/lift off ground timber and cellulose materials stored in subfloors & grounds, be careful not to disturb any termite activity or damage. If you do replace it quickly.
- Remove excess stored materials in all areas
- Unlock all locked areas/create access (remember fuse box, garage, shed etc.)
- Locate documentation relating to your past reports and treatments & make a copy available to your professional pest manager

## **AFTER TREATMENT**
